Fred Ewell, (FE) Treasurer of the Booster Club Opened the meeting at 7:35 by welcoming everyone. He thanked everyone for coming. FE gave a brief overview of the meeting which would include nominations for the coming year booster club. Last month minutes approved.

Treasurer's Report

FE announced that our account balance as of 1/6/09 is \$35,572.76. The past-month included income of \$1,260.00 for the banquet, \$1,653.00 for clothing sales and an additional \$973.00 for the Gold Card. There were payments made to Mastoris of approx. \$4750.00 for the banquet, \$8,900.00 was paid to the unpaid coaches. There are still some outstanding payments to TSS for pictures and a few minor other items. The report was moved for approval by FE and John Pulley seconded.

Committee Reports

Clothing

Cindy Donnell we need to discuss a new design and if we want to put a saying on the back of the Tee shirts. There are quite a few items of clothing in inventory that need to be discussed. The design and saying were tabled until the next meeting. In the meantime anyone with a suggestion for a saying should email Cindy Donnell. Coach Caruso discussed getting sweatshirts and sweat pants for the kids with their numbers on both.

Task

Susan Ferrara updated us on the January 6, 2009 trip to task. There was a new driver this month. There is a driver for February but we need to get volunteers going forward for the first Tuesday of every month.

Website

Tesa Danaso is working towards getting the 2008 information off the site. She will continue to work with Marc Szabo on the site updates. Cathy Manfredi has also volunteered to assist in this effort. Tesa

also noted she heard from the Trentonian and they were sending Coach Caruso a check for the football program.

Alumni

Terry McCarty is getting calls regarding the alumni information on the Hamilton School TV station. Most are being directed to the website. He also discussed The Spartan club, the money in this fund is for Long Term Capital Improvements. He is working on getting 5 more founding members. The booster club can become a founding member as well. Discussion around sending a letter to the Times, newspaper for their support on the 50th anniversary. It was the understanding that the school board was handling this for both schools.

Coaches Report

Off season lifting began. There was a team meeting afterschool on 1/5/09. There were 105 in attendance. Any player involved in a winter or spring sport are excused from lifting. At the first few sessions there were 70 players in the weight room. The program for lifting was discussed. There was an email sent for equipment needed in the weight room. There was a motion by Terry McCarty to approve a new line item of \$1,000.00 to the budget for equipment. Denise Koval seconded. Vote unanimously approved. Additional equipment for weight room is being donated by the Y to each school. Any currently unused equipment will be stored in PODs.

The coaches would like to attend the Glazier Clinic for Coaches in Cherry Hill. There is staff fee of \$400.00 allowing approximately 12 -15 coaches. We could extend to feeder programs. Denise Koval motioned to approve. Beth Riese seconded.

Change to scrimmage schedule for 2009 season is in process. Hunterdon Central not on schedule for next year possibility of Ewing and/or Rancocas Valley to be added.

Camp – The possibility of going to Sea Girt Base for the 4 days of camp (8/16, 17, 18 and 19) are being discussed. This would be for Varsity and JV players. There is a fee for each player and we would need to bring all equipment. This is pending initial correspondence to the Base from Steinert on school letter head.

Coach Caruso has an invoice for the 12th man Football club of approx. \$400.00. This is the fee for the coaches to attend the dinners.

Tutoring sessions were discussed.
