Seniors will have the ability to purchase their uniforms. Overall this has been a very successful season. There will no longer be a CVC Conference for football. It will be called the West Jersey Football League. Steinert will be in Div. 3A. Football will be the first to play in this type of system, other sports teams will follow. The playoff system will still be the same. As will the annual Thanksgiving Day game. The scoreboard is in and will be installed on Monday, November 16. Our cost is \$2,494.91 for 50% of the installation cost. The school paid for the board and the Track Team paid for the other half of the installation. We were hoping The Haldeman Ford fundraiser would cover the cost of the installation fees. Terry McCarty motioned to approve the funding until the officers can meet to discuss the budget. Denise Koval 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. CC put in a bid from another school for Goal Posts for next year. If we lose the bid he would like to put this on a wish list for next year. Rogers Athletic, water machine, the bill is past due. This is another budget issue that will be discussed by the officers. Additionally, one of the wheels is broken. Sprinkler system on the practice field is still not approved by the township. They have been out to approve the electrical for hook up.
